English

Your child's English topic is based around the text 'The Hound of the Baskervilles' by Arthur Conan Doyle. Your child will:

- Read and explore cliff-hanger narratives
- Write a cliff-hanger narrative independently
- Explore the difference between formal and informal speech and vocabulary
- Use commas and hyphens to clarify meaning and avoid ambiguity
- Use semi-colons to mark boundaries between independent clauses
- Re-visit the use of relative clauses

Science

Your child's Science topic is Forces. Your child will:

- Learn what a force is
- Learn what happens when friction is low/high
- Understand what resistance is
- Investigate gravity

Your child should:

- Bring a reading book home and read at home each night

- Solve problems with multiplication and division
- Multiply 2x2 digit numbers
- Multiply 4x2 digit numbers
- Divide a 4-digit number by a 1 digit, including questions with remainders
- Calculate fractions of an amount
- Multiply fractions
