And	Using two terms to search a database, E.g. Find all the boys with brown hair	
Branching Database	A method for classifying objects. If designed correctly, it can be used to identify an object	
Data	Raw numbers and figures	
Field	A data structure for a single piece of information in a databse, E.g. hair colour, eye colour	
Information	Knowledge about a subject	
Or	To search a database for one item or another, E.g. Children with blue or brown eyes	
Organise	To arrange or order things or events systematically	
Search	To look through a database for a word of group of words	
Sort	To put the information in the database into an order	



Key Vocabulary		
Algorithm	A precise set of ordered steps that can be followed by a human or a computer to achieve a task	
Code	The commands that a computer can run	
Debug	To find and correct errors in a program	
Forever	When an algorithm is repeated indefinitely until told otherwise	
Loop	An instruction that repeats until a specific condition is met	
Repeat	A type of loop, instructions that are repeated a given number of times	
Sequence	A set of instructions that are followed in order	
Variable	A named piece of memory that holds a value, E.g. points in a game or number of lives

Algorithm	A precise set of ordered steps that can be followed by a human or a computer to achieve a task	
Debugging	The process of finding and correcting errors in a program	
Input	Data that is sent to a program to be processed	
Programming	The process of creating instructions for a computer to follow in order to perform certain tasks	
Repetition	Part of a program where one or more commands are run multiple times in a loop	
Selection	Part of a program where if a condition is met, then a set of commands is run	
Sequence	A set of instructions that are followed in order	
Tinker	To explore and experiment with a device or some software

Audio	Sound recorded, processed or produced as an output	
CGI (Computer Generated Imagery)	The use of computer graphics in art and media	
Green Screen	A process where an image or video is created using a green background, allowing any image to replace the background.	
Image	A picture that is taken or stored using a computer or device	
Special Effects	A method of creating images that do not exist in real life	
Text	On-screen words and letters	
Video	A recording of an image or of moving images

Image	A visual representation or picture of something	
Keyword	A word or phrase that is used to represent a particular topic or subject in a search	
Personal data	Information that is specific to an individual, such as their name, age, address, or telephone number	
Reliable	Online information that can be trusted	
Search Engine	A program or website that is used to search and find information on the internet by using keywords	
Sharing	The act of giving, exchanging, or distributing something with others	
Website	A collection of web pages that are connected and accessed through the internet

Algebra	A system of logical reasoning that uses letters and symbols to represent numbers and quantities in equations and formulas	
Binary	The language computers use. It is a series of Is and Os	
Columns	A vertical line of data	
Formula	A set of mathematical instructions or rules that help solve a problem or perform a calculation	
Pixel	The smallest unit of a digital image or a picture on a computer screen	
Rows	A horizontal line of data	
Spreadsheet	A file that exists of cells in rows and columns and can help arrange, calculate, and sort data
